Livestock Agreement



1) Drug Statement

- Owner acknowledges that the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act prohibits the introduction or delivery into the interstate commerce of any food that is adulterated or misbranded. Adulteration includes poisonous or deleterious substances, and any new animal drugs defined as unsafe within the meaning of Section 512 (21 USC Section 260b) of that act and those drugs listed in Section 402 (21 USC Section 342).
- Owner is responsible for the animals, which are rejected at processing center due to the presence of drug residues.
- Owner shall report to management any and all drugs or medications administered to an animal that might still be detected at the time of showing. The name of the drug, dosage, its purpose, time and date of administration will be required. This must be done prior to showing of animal.
- Owner is responsible for any fees that arise from the processor caring for the animal while waiting the specified time to process after the use of drugs. If the processor refuses care of the animal, for the time specified for the drug used, the Owner may care for the animal and make the appropriate arrangements with the buyer and the processor.
