

Sacramento County Fair's Farm Garden in a Wheelbarrow

Rules and Guidelines:

1. Your fair display must include your wheelbarrow, a tri-fold board with photos and information about your project and your class display of learning.
2. Your tri-fold board cannot be extended in any way and information can only be displayed on one side. Board must include the name of your school, grade level and teachers name.
3. Your display of learning is to be a journal assignment from one of your lessons or activities. Journal must include some form of writing assignment and a picture. Teachers with students in the Kindergarten grade level can use photo journals if necessary. Journals must be together in a binder. **Assignments should be placed in protective sheets to keep them neat and clean.
4. ALL work should be done by STUDENTS. Teachers can assist when necessary.
5. Your wheelbarrow should be decorated to the fair theme "Let Eat, Have Fun and Celebrate the Red, White and Blue.
6. Student's names must be attached to the handle(s) of your wheelbarrow. Be creative!
7. Materials provided: lesson plans, wheelbarrow, soil, seeds to grow Red Romaine Lettuce, Green Romaine Lettuce, Watermelon Radishes, and Beets (the ingredients of a salad)
8. Judging will be based off the given criteria sheet and the judges will be one Master Gardener, one teacher from another county, and one fair employee.
9. After completion of the competition, participants are encouraged to pick up their fair display and enjoy a homegrown salad from their garden in a wheelbarrow.

Awards:

First, Second and Third will be awarded to each class. Best of Show will be selected among all entries. Each garden will receive a participation ribbon for the classroom.
